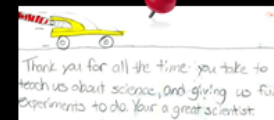


Thank you for teaching 5th grade so many things! You are really cool and everyone likes you. It stinks that we won't see you next year!

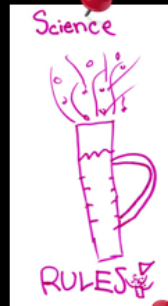
